## **TRANSPLANTING VALUES - TRANSFORMING INDIVIDUALS→ BUILDING A TEAM - IMPACTING THE COMMUNITY: A DECADE OF THE ICR STUDY GROUP, KOLHAPUR**

Our Sir had claimed in rather bold letters more than a quarter of century ago-  
**ICR DELIVERS: Hahnemann.\***

What does this mean? In this day and in this age? And to this generation? Do we?

The second millennium has begun with widespread globalization and market-driven ventures with technology in the forefront. Homoeopathy is not lagging far behind in all of these. We see hi-tech Homoeopathy being branded in our metros. We hear of it being delivered on the internet 'live'. We are told of the vast impact of a single dose - revolutionizing the mind and the body, ridding it of diseases afflicting it through generations!
