I am pleased to inform you that in continuation with the module based Reorientation training programme for Teachers of Homoeopathic Colleges in the subject of *Organon & Homoeopathic Philosophy*, sanctioned by the Department of AYUSH, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, we propose to conduct a programme based on **Module 2 from Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> May 2009 to Saturday, 9<sup>th</sup> May 2009**

In February 2008, and Oct 2008 we successfully conducted ROTP's in Module 3 and Module 1 respectively, which covered the

*Fundamental concepts of Health, Disease, Cure, Individualization, Drug Proving, Miasms, Auxiliary measures, diet and regimen. and its applications in Homoeopathic management of various categories of diseases as stated in Organon*

*And Basic psychology of human being – Intelligence and thinking, Perception and cognition, Emotions and motivations, Personality. Logic of Homoeopathy. Comparative study of different systems of Medicine stated in Organon of Medicine and also modern medicine and Ayurveda. Concept of Vital Principle.*

These modules were attended by 27 teachers, in Module 3 and 14 teachers in Module 1 from all over India and one from Nepal. They appreciated the presentations which were lively, delivered rich clinical experiences and demonstrated a practical approach to the study and teaching of the subject. Institutional set up and facilities provided at the venue were also appreciated.

**Module 2** which has been chosen for this ROT has the following topics:

*Critical study of different editions of Organon of Medicine. Detailed and comparative study of 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> editions of Organon of Medicine. Essay on a new principle for ascertaining the curative powers of drugs. Medicine of experience.*

This will cover the study of evolution of the fundamental principles of Homoeopathy, in the works of Master Samuel Hahnemann and how he evolved methods & techniques to support the concepts he derived through scientific experiments. This will enhance our understanding of the principles and demonstrate the application of the same in practice. Teachers will experientially develop a creative and integrated approach to the teaching of the subject, in literary research, perceiving, recording, analysis, synthesis and conceptualizing the 'TOTALITY'.

## **Methodology**

The exposure will comprise of demonstrating how to study the literature and also practical and case based presentations in application of fundamental principles in practice. The participants will derive benefit from the rich clinical material from the different clinical centres of the Institute and from a variety of approaches presented by able teachers of the subject from all over the country.. It is essential that the teacher exposes himself/herself to the entire series to get a good grasp of the entire subject.

## **Participants and Facilities**

As you will see the topics will be of benefit to the teacher of Homoeopathic subjects as well. There are limited seats in the programme. You are requested to sponsor teacher/s from your institution. As per the rules, they will be eligible for reimbursement of the actual fare of AC 2 tier class. They would be paid Rs. 1000/- per day to cover their lodging and boarding expenses. 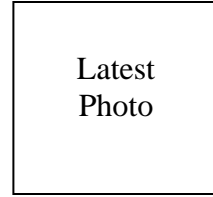
